## St. John Fisher Parish: Bonfire Guidelines

- **Fire Supervision:** The fire shall be constantly attended until the fire is completely extinguished.
- **Bonfire Location:** All bonfires shall be in the permanent fire pit location on the back deck.
- **Fire Ignition & Fuel:** Fuel for the bonfire shall consist only of dry firewood, and the fire may be ignited only with a small amount of paper or campfire starter material designed for that purpose. The fire shall not be started by anything except matches or a lighter, and shall not be ignited or fueled with flammable liquids.
- **Fire Size:** Fires must be contained in the issued fire pit(s) and cannot exceed three feet in diameter and three feet in height.
- **Bonfire Duration:** Fires are permitted between the hours of 5:00 pm and 12:00 am and shall not burn longer than three hours.
- **Safety Behavior:** Jumping over the bonfire or general horseplay near the fire will not be allowed. Any behavior by an individual or group of individuals in attendance that puts the health and safety of themselves, others, or the community at risk is prohibited.
- **Emergency Extinguishing:** A 3 gallon bucket (minimum) of water is required near the fire pit. A fire extinguisher must be nearby at all times. (Fire extinguishers should be discharged only in cases of emergency and should not be used for routine extinguishing of fires. If a fire extinguisher is used, the parish office must be notified. The parish will make sure the fire extinguisher is recharged or replaced and put back into service as soon as possible.)

*Failure to comply with above policies will result in the loss of future privileges for the violating group or organization.*
